These activities may include product development, using modified starches, sweeteners, and specialty products (e.g. sweeteners, polydextrose, sucralose, fibers, and maltodextrins); product evaluation, using analytical and/or physical testing equipment; assisting in training sessions; participating in or conducting sensory evaluation; and conducting process development studies. This internship will include assignment to a specific project for the duration of the summer. We offer competitive compensation and summer housing is provided if needed.
